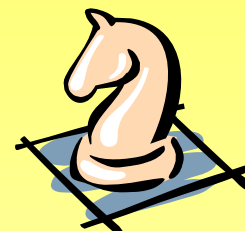


Hot Summer Chess

Lessons and Grand Prix 2007



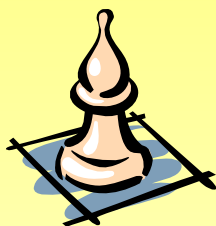
Play in one or play in all four!
